impetigo

a highly contagious skin infection that causes red sores or blisters

"After you take the medicine for at least 24 hours, impetigo isn't contagious anymore."

inflammation

reddening and swelling of a body part as a reaction to injury or infection

"The infection led to inflammation around the affected area."

laryngitis

inflammation of the voice box

"He wasn't able to give his speech, as his laryngitis made speaking painful."
